Oppose postal privatization (H.Res. 70)

Nearly 376 million pieces of mail and packages are delivered to more than 168.6 mil—lion addresses at least six days a week by the U.S. Postal Service. USPS's universal service obligation allows communities large and small to benefit from the same level of service, regardless of location, wealth, or what is being delivered. It also allows USPS to partner with private shippers, which would be unable or unwilling to service much of the country.

With founding principles in the U.S. Constitution, the nation's post office will celebrate its 250th anniversary later this year. USPS is a self-sustaining, independent establishment of the federal government, does not receive taxpayer funding, and relies on revenue derived from the sale of postal services and products. Despite popular news coverage of a USPS financial crisis, 80 percent of its losses are due to factors outside its control and can be addressed by allowing USPS to continue with its current network modernization plans and by focusing on other legislative remedies that will ensure the Postal Service continues to provide its important public service far into the future.

Postal privatization imperils far more than its supporters reveal. It is not the answer to the USPS's financial crisis and would not benefit the American public.

The Postal Service is the core of the U.S. mailing industry With 640,000 employees, USPS is at the center of the \$1.92 trillion mailing industry that employs more than 7.9 million Americans (5 percent of all jobs nationwide).

USPS's universal network plays a crucial role in the function of private shippers such as FedEx and Amazon, which partner with USPS • because it provides unique last-mile delivery to every business and residential customer in the country six and, increasingly, seven days a week. This reliable, efficient service is too costly for private shippers to maintain alone, particularly for rural customers.

The Postal Service is a lifeline

USPS's massive infrastructure guarantees that no matter where you are in the country—urban, suburban or rural—USPS will deliver to you. Every day, millions of Americans rely on this vast system for the delivery of prescription drugs, Social Security and pension checks, and essential goods.

In times of national crisis, USPS's infrastructure also provides a ready and robust means of communication and distribution. Most recently, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Postal Service delivered critical

The Postal Service is secure

Mail and packages carried by USPS are protected by more than 200 federal laws enforced by the U.S. Postal Inspection Service. Founded by Benjamin Franklin and established on Aug. 7, 1775, the Inspection Service is one of the nation's oldest federal law enforcement agencies.

The agency targets theft, disrupts drug traffickers, prevents crimes, uncovers fraud and scams, and keeps customers, employees and mail safe. The Inspection Service does this with approximately 2,400 employees, including 1,300 postal inspectors and 500 uniformed postal police officers all working to ensure America's confidence in the U.S. Mail.

The Postal Service is much more than a delivery service USPS letter carriers provide far more than the delivery of mail and packages. They are members of the community, the eyes and ears of their neighborhoods, and often the only source of daily contact for the elderly and disabled. They often serve as first responders for lost children and the victims of crimes, accidents and fires. They provide the first sense of normalcy after hurricanes, floods, and other natural disasters.

The Postal Service is also one of the nation's largest employers of U.S. military veterans and remains the most popular government entity in the United States, consistently ranked as one of the most trusted federal agencies by the American people.

International impacts of privatization harm the public
International postal privatization and profit maximization efforts
have resulted in disinvestment, lower service quality, and higher
prices (despite more competi–tion), as well as drastic cuts to both
employment and wages across the entire delivery industry.

Privately owned post offices only operate in areas deemed lucrative, resulting in large sections of unserved rural, sub-urban, and even low-income urban areas. For example, the privatization of the Italian, Danish, Norwegian and Finnish postal systems has led to slower delivery times, reductions in the frequency of delivery to as few as three days a week, and, in some cases, the discontinuation of delivery to rural residents. These service reductions would be foolish when more and more people rely on delivery for purchased goods and the frequency of delivery is increasing in the United States.

Stamp prices have increased significantly in countries with privatized postal systems. For example, since 2010, stamp prices have more than doubled in Italy and more than tripled in the UK, while the price of a stamp has only increased 66 percent in the United States. In fact, according to an analysis by the USPS OIG, USPS stamp prices are the most affordable in the world, when compared to 30 other countries with postal systems relatively comparable to the USPS.

Privatizing the Postal Service would have far-reaching negative consequences nationwide, including:

- Jeopardizing the jobs of 640,000 postal employees, more than 73,000 of whom are military veterans, and affecting the 7.9 million Americans in the mailing industry.
- Endangering the security of the nation's mail system, threatening the safe delivery of prescription drugs, money and election mail.
- Slashing service quality and hiking prices beyond affordability.
- Potentially ceasing delivery for America's rural and low-income communities, negatively affecting nearly all 50 states in some form, but especially large, less-populous regions.

NALC opposes postal privatization in all forms and supports H.Res. 70, which calls on Congress to ensure that the Postal Service remains an independent establishment and not subject to privatization. Sponsored by Reps. Stephen Lynch (D-MA) and Nick LaLota (R-NY)

Why is Congress so important?



 ARTICLE I, SECTION 8, CLAUSE 7 OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION, KNOWN AS THE POSTAL CLAUSE OR THE POSTAL POWER, EMPOWERS CONGRESS "TO ESTABLISH POST OFFICES AND POST ROADS".



Article 43.1

Enacted Legislation: Social Security Reform Act (1983 to 2025)

The Government Pension Offset (GPO) and the Windfall Elimination **Provision (WEP)** were created by Congress and both signed into law by President Ronald Reagan in 1983 as part of the Social Security Reform Act. State and local governments played no role in accepting or approving these laws.

Both are federal laws that reduced social security benefits for individuals who also receive a pension from a job that was not covered by social security taxes, typically government jobs; Federal CSRS retirees, State and local government retirees, teachers, police, firefighters, postal workers and air traffic controllers.



Enacted Legislation: Social Security Reform Act

(GPO) Government Pension Offset, reduced Social Security benefits for spouses, widows and widowers who also received government pensions of their own.

(WEP) Windfall Elimination Provision, reduced Social Security benefits for Individuals who also receive a pension or disability benefit from an employer that did not withhold social security taxes.

Founded 15 years before the enactment of social security, the CSRS was designed to stand alone. Unlike most employer-sponsored pensions in the private sector, CSRS annuities were not intended to supplement Social Security benefits.



Enacted Legislation: Social Security Reform Act

- Federal government workers, including postal workers, who were hired before 1983 didn't pay social security taxes. Instead, these workers paid into the Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS), a different benefits program.
- One of the amendments mandated Social Security coverage for all federal and postal employees hired on or after January 1, 1984.
- How much will my Social Security benefits be reduced? We'll reduce your Social Security benefits by two-thirds of your government pension. For example, if you get a monthly civil service pension of \$3,000, two-thirds of that, or \$2,000, must be deducted from your Social Security benefits.



These laws were repealed by the Social Security Fairness Act – HR 82 which was signed into law on January 6, 2025

These changes are effective for benefits payable after December 2023.



Enacted Legislation: 2006 Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act (2006 to 2022)

- A Bill passed under a lame duck session of Congress, to have the USPS "pre-fund" decades' worth of health benefits for its future retirees, 90 years into the future! Billions of dollars in the hole overnight.
- The mandate cost an average of \$5.2 billion annually since 2007; and was responsible for 84 percent of USPS losses over the fifteen years prior to 2022.
- Were this burden not imposed, <u>USPS would have recorded</u> <u>surpluses of nearly \$4.0 billion in that time</u>.



Enacted Legislation: 2006 Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act

COP-3 DAY WAITING PERIOD

- Is another provision of the PAE and is an amendment to the Federal Employees' Compensation Act (FECA) which is administered by the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP).
- The amendment, <u>only</u> applies to USPS employees and establishes a three-day waiting period before Continuation of Pay (COP) will be granted.
- A COP-eligible employee may use annual leave, sick leave, or leave without pay during the three-day period. Translation: The first 3 days you have an injury you must use your own leave.



H. R. 3076 (Postal Service Reform Act) Signed into law April 2022

- This bill deals with meaningful postal reform and was out top legislative issue for over 15 years.
- Passage of this legislation allowed us to repeal the pre-funding mandate, codify 6-Day delivery into federal law and maximize the integration of future postal annuitants into Medicare.



THE 119TH CONGRESS (JAN 3, 2025 – JAN 3, 2027)

Any previous House and Senate Bills/Resolutions from prior sessions have to be reintroduced into each new Congress!



Trump Administration 2.0 and Letter Carriers

During his first term, Trump's Postal Service task force called for the elimination of our right to collectively bargain our wages and other terms of employment.

The DOGE (Dept of Government Efficiency) is a federal advisory committee—job is to cut \$2 trillion in spending, in part by "deleting" or trimming several agencies, USPS included.

Trump Administration 2.0 and Letter Carriers

Postal Service critics frequently complain that the agency is "losing money." But the Postal Service is still a government department, like the Defense Department and Agriculture Department. We accept that operating those agencies costs money, because we believe the country should have a military and monitor crop yields. And it should give health coverage to veterans, and maintain highways, and have courts, and do a thousand other things, too. That's why we pay taxes.

Letter carriers know that the Postal Service does not use taxpayer money for its operations. Educating members of Congress who are ignorant about this fact has, and will continue to be, a major challenge, which means that we have our work cut out for us.

According to the public, the Postal Service has one of the highest approval ratings of any government agency, second to the National Park Service. 72% of Americans have a favorable view of the USPS. Only the National Park Service scored higher with 76%.

NALC's PAC was created in 1975.


A PAC (political action committee) is a type of organization that pools contributions from members and donates those funds to campaigns for or against candidates, ballot initiatives or legislation.








Installation instructions for Android and iPhone

Apple iPhone and iPad

On Apple iPhones, find the App Store (the letter A in a circle on a blue button) on your phone's home screen.

In the gray search bar at the top, enter "NALC Member App." Then hit the blue search button in the lower right.

When you see the app, click the blue "Cet" button at the right, and then it will turn to a green "Install" button. Click that. You will be asked for your password or touch ID, depending on how you've set up your phone. Once you authorize the installation, it will begin.

 When completed, there will be a blue "Open" button, if you want to use it immediately. The NALC Member App also will appear on your home screen for whenever you want to use it.

While the app was built for phones, it can be used on iPads as well. Follow the instructions above, but your search will not find the NALK Member App. Simply go to the top left where it says in blue, "iPad Only" and change it to "iPhone Only" You should now be able to download the app with the instructions above. Once the iPhone app is installed, you'll notice that it will automati-

nassement, you in notice that it will automatically scale up to display full-size on the iPad screen, causing the buttons, fonts and graphics to look proportionately larger than normal.
